## **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

On 14th February 2024, the NSS Cell of HITS, in collaboration with the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) Cell, Day celebrated Founder's Memorial with compassionate and impactful initiative. The event, orchestrated by the Dr. KCG Verghese Charitable empower aimed to marginalized communities and promote inclusivity. The benevolent acts included the donation of 10 tricycles for physically challenged individuals and 10 sewing machines for selfhelp groups in the HITS adopted villages under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan scheme.

The benevolent act unfolded with Dr. Mrs. Elizabeth Verghese, Founder Chairperson, Dr. Anand Jacob Verghese, Chairman of Hindustan Group of Institutions, accompanied by the Management officials, personally distributing the tricycles and sewing machines to the deserving beneficiaries. #### **Mega Wedding contribution**

Dr. K.C.G. Verghese Charitable Foundation contributed Rs. 1,80,000 towards the wedding expenses of three couples in a Mega Wedding conducted by the Ys Men Club of Coimbatore for 14 destitute couples.
